## Reporting:

### Membership

- The names of 14 New Full Members and 5 HYB members approved.
- Amendments to the Auction Sale Rules were approved. A copy will become available on the Holstein UK Website.
- With Effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April All MALE registrations will be subjected to parentage verification. The cost for verification of the Sire and Dam if required will be borne by Holstein UK.
- The approved Disciplinary and Showing Rules will be circulated to the general membership, and will be available on the web site.
- The Type Merit Working Group met recently and is evaluating a number of key points for consideration. Holstein UK are extremely concerned regarding recent comments by DairyCo regarding the value of 'Type'.
- Holstein UK and DairyCo will have Genomic Index calculations available in April – For males only.
- The Society will look to be proactive in encouraging participation in Health & Welfare Schemes.
- Nominations for office of President 2013/14 required for April.
- Lifetime Achievement Award Nominations required for April.
- New Trustees nomination form in circulation. Closing Date 31<sup>st</sup> March. (South Wales, Yorkshire, Southern and Scotland)
