

## JULY 2011 BOARD SUMMARY

### Reporting;

- The ANNUAL REPORT & ACCOUNTS 2011 were presented to the Board. These disclose an increase in reserves of £232,580. The accounts will be printed and published in a forthcoming Journal.
- The Board acknowledged that the presentation of the ALL BRITAIN AWARDS could have been handled better and recommended a formal presentation dinner be held in future.
- The 'Elite' sale produced an average £4,076.
- The Judging Rules for all levels will be revised in due course.
- The names of unsuccessful nominee's for President will be retained for future elections. All clubs are eligible to put forward names for future consideration.
- The Board considered the Rules for Classification which will be published in a forthcoming Journal and be produced in Brochure format for on farm retention.
- The Rules for Showing at the National All Breeds had been finalised and would be available with the schedule, due out early July.
